What Employers Are Facing Today

Employers of nearly every size and industry are facing economic hardship as a result of the health pandemic. The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act addresses the needs of employers who, despite fully or partially suspended business activities, have continued to compensate employees. Under Section 2301 of the CARES Act, eligible employers can claim a tax credit against applicable employment taxes your business has paid for employees retained during the COVID-19 crisis. The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021¹ extended the credit through June 30, 2021 with some modifications.

Relief Is Available

The CARES Act employee retention tax credits benefits to eligible employers include:



A tax credit equal to: (i) **50% of qualified wages** paid from March 13, 2020 through December 31, 2020, up to \$10,000 of wages in the aggregate per employee; and (ii) **70% of qualified wages** paid from January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021, up to \$10,000 of wages per employee per quarter



A maximum tax credit value of: (i) up to \$5,000 per employee, based on wages paid from March 13, 2020 through December 31, 2020; and (ii) up to \$14,000 per employee, based on wages paid from January 1, 2021 through December 31. 2021

An employer with 2,000 employees each eligible for the maximum credit value could receive a retention tax credit of a maximum of \$10MM in 2020 and a maximum of \$28MM for 2021 (1st and 2nd quarters)?


